Portugal has earned a reputation as one of the most important destinations for SSC/ITO/BPO service centres in Europe. While Portugal is currently "hot", given increasing demand for talent and competitive location advantages, Portugal's potential to grow and the sector's ability to flourish, depend on the country's ability to leverage a successful past to build new capabilities aligned to future requirements.

On March 12th at the *Palácio da Bolsa* in the Northern city of Porto, the symposium **«Portugal Future Nearshore »** will explore initial results from a multi-stage project focused on creating the right framework and investments to broaden and accelerate Portugal's development of the business services sector. The Symposium emphasizes the opportunities and challenges in Portugal to stimulate and support the sector, and highlights new initiatives and success stories that are shaping the ability for businesses to seize value through services and investments in Portugal.

The FUTURE NEARSHORE PROJECT addresses key areas including:

- Challenges in attracting, maintaining, and growing international service operations.
- > Human resources and adaptations and investments required to support new business services.
- Positioning and further developing Portugal as the preferred Nearshore destination for business services.

The March 12th symposium and project are hosted and co-financed by **TICE**, the Portuguese Platform for Information Technology and Electronic Communication, along with partners and stakeholders including the **Portugal Outsourcing Association** (APO), **Computer Graphics Centre** and **PowerData**.
